# SUNDAYS DURING CONSTRUCTION

**PART ONE - What to expect during the "exile"** – that is, while we are forced to move to the Fellowship Hall for worship during Sanctuary renovations! What will it be like when construction starts? Different, for sure! Here are some of the details you'll want to know.

- 1. How will I enter the church?** Starting on Sunday, October 31<sup>st</sup> our Sunday services will take place in the Fellowship Hall. The main entrance into the building during construction will be through the Office entrance adjacent to the handicap ramp. The triple doors from the parking lot and the doors at the "seam" between the Sanctuary and Fellowship Hall will be closed off. On October 26<sup>th</sup> temporary walls will go up at the end of the hallway nearest the Sanctuary and at the Sanctuary end of the Fellowship Hall in order to block off the area being renovated.
- 2. How will I get my children to KidsLife?** When you enter the building through the Office entrance, you'll see that the stairway on your right (which you may not know is there – it's been covered for years) will have been re-opened, giving access to the ground floor and the KidsLife classrooms. Check-in for KidsLife will take place at the bottom of those stairs.
- 3. Where will we go to sign in on Sundays?** The Welcome Desk will be relocated to the lobby outside the Office, convenient to everyone entering the building. We will still want to record attendance, so be sure to stop by and say hello. We expect lots of activity here as people come and go. Traffic may be especially heavy between services, so please try not to linger in this area.
- 4. Where will we park?** Some of the parking lot will be fenced off during construction. For those who can, please park farther away from the building and walk up to the Office entrance. Save as many handicap parking spaces and parking spaces near the Office entrance for those with limited mobility.
