SUNDAYS DURING CONSTRUCTION

PART TWO - What to expect during the "exile," that is, while we hold Sunday services in the Fellowship Hall during Sanctuary renovations! Here are some more details you'll want to know.

- 1. What will the seating in the Fellowship Hall be like?** There are currently 275 seats in the Sanctuary. We'll reduce that to about 200 seats in the Fellowship Hall when the layout is complete. The 9am service has had an average of 100 people in attendance in recent weeks, and attendance at the 10:45am service has ranged from 160 to 200. So, if you want a little more elbow room, come to the 9am service. If you have a favorite spot where you like to sit, come early to grab your seat! Overflow seating will be available in The 109 and the Library (lecture side) during the 10:45 service.
- 2. What about airflow in the Fellowship Hall?** The heating/air conditioning system in the Fellowship Hall is newer than the one in the Sanctuary. This system automatically exhausts some room air and mixes in fresh outside air. By doing this the room is constantly being fed fresh conditioned air. So, though the room is smaller, the circulating air will actually be fresher. And, remember how cold we were last winter when we kept the windows open for fresh air? Thanks to this new system, we should be much more comfortable this winter.
- 3. Will there be music during the service?** YES! Because the stage area will be smaller, so might the band. Some Sundays there may be only one musician and a song leader. Other Sundays, maybe more. In either case, we'll continue to sing in worship of our God and King. Enjoy the diversity and uniqueness of each Sunday's worship time.
- 4. Will I be able to see what's happening up front during services?** There will be only one large screen in the front of the room for the display of song lyrics and sermon slides. Since the screen is centered, expect that the preacher will be standing off to one side. The band will be set up off to the side as well. Both the band and the preacher will stand on a platform, so seeing them shouldn't be a problem.
- 5. Will there be a Fellowship Café between services?** YES. Coffee and tea service will be set up on the counter in the Kitchen window. Some seating may be set up down the hallway for people to sit and chat, but please remember not to congregate outside the double doors between the Fellowship Hall and the Kitchen lobby - they are not an effective sound barrier! We may have to reconsider the Café location if it gets too noisy.
