- The Fellowship Café coffee and tea service will be set up in the Kitchen window between services. Remember not to congregate outside the double doors between the Kitchen and the Fellowship Hall.

# CAPITAL CAMPAIGN UPDATE

Thank you for your faithfulness in giving to the Capital Campaign. The original pledge period was three years, beginning in December 2018 and running through to the end of this year. There were many people whose giving began in January 2019, so we expect to receive their final contributions in January 2022. You may recall that we reopened the campaign briefly when the final building design was presented, so although most contributions are expected to be completed in the next 3 or 4 months, approximately \$60,000 of additional funds will continue to be received throughout 2022. Greg Raysor, Administrator and Michael Todd, Treasurer are working to finalize the September financial close. Once that is complete, Capital Campaign contribution updates will be sent to those who pledged, and total contributions received to date will be reported.

# FOOD CUPBOARD REPORT

During the five weeks of September 2021, the Food Cupboard had 157 households coming through our doors to select food which included various canned goods, dry goods, baked items, breads/bagels, produce, frozen meat, and frozen seafood. The number of people within these households over the five weeks totaled 299 people fed.
